FIRST

You need to go to Skyzone website and fill out the online release:

You will not jump if you do not sign this release!

SECOND

You will need to sign the "RELEASE OF LIABILITY" form on the last page for Skyzone. Again, you cannot jump without this form signed.

THIRD

The last reason for this letter is to obtain a permission slip/release of liability form for The Escape Unit to be signed and returned by March 17th, 2017 (to Pam Erickson at the school).

Tips from Skyzone:

HAVE FUN, FLY SAFE!

Sky Zone is designed for everyone, and we want to make sure you fly safe. We ask that you become familiar with and abide by the rules below. Remember, stay in your comfort zone! DO NOT ATTEMPT any activity, flip, jump or trick you don't think you can handle. Flips or other tricks can be dangerous ... perform at your own risk. Sky Zone Team Members help ensure that rules and regulations are followed. Jumpers should not engage in court activities without a Zone Team Member present. Here are the rules to fly by:

****Everyone that enters the Sky Zone court must have completed a valid and signed Sky Zone waiver. Those under 18 must have it signed/completed by their parent, legal guardian, or someone with power of attorney.****

ALWAYS...

- remove street shoes / wear SkySocks.
- empty your pockets entirely.
- maintain one person per square.
- walk onto and off the courts.
- be in control of your body at all times.
- perform at your own risk. Flips and other tricks can be dangerous.
- be aware of those around you and jump with people that are of similar age/size.
- master the fundamentals of single trampoline jumping before moving onto more advanced skills, such as aerial or flipping type skills.
- land on the first trampoline next to the trampoline wall you bounced off of, when bouncing and flipping off trampoline side walls.
- follow all park rules and the Court Monitor's instructions.

DO NOT...

- land on your head or neck.
- wear wet clothes or body paint.
- have anything in your mouth (gum, candy, etc.).
- touch any perimeter netting or top pads.
- throw balls at another jumper's head or neck area.
- do more than two single flips in a row.
- double flip, and do not flip over the pads. Single flips are permitted.
- double bounce or affect another jumper's bounce in any way.
- push, tackle, run on flat surfaces, race, or engage in horseplay of any kind.
- sit or lie on the court. If you are tired and need to rest, you must exit the court.
- attempt any skill or activity outside of your personal limitations, abilities or skill level.
- jump if you have health limitations, are under the influence of alcohol, drugs or if you are pregnant.
- JUMP IF A COURT MONITOR IS NOT PRESENT.
 - Failure to adhere to any of these or other rules at Sky Zone can/will result in the loss of your jump time. Thank you for always following our safety guidelines. We want you to have fun and fly safe!

RELEASE OF LIABILITY

THIS RELEASE OF LIABILITY is given in consideration of _____ being permitted to participate in the activities described below. I, for myself, my personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin state as follows:

1. The above-named individual wishes to participate in certain activities taking place on the premises of ReddGal, LLC, operated by R2BTOO, Inc., d/b/a SKYZONE (collectively, "SKYZONE"), located at 5129 South Solberg Avenue, Sioux Falls, South Dakota. Such activities include live performances by outside entertainment acts including, but not limited to, comedians, magicians, bands and hypnotists performing before audiences ("Live Performances"). The terms of this Release shall apply to any such Live Performances which occur within the SKYZONE premises. Furthermore, this Release will apply to the above-named individual's participation as a Live Performances audience member and to any additional involvement including, but not limited to, on stage participation in such Live Performances.
2. The undersigned individuals expressly acknowledge and understand that participation in the Live Performances may involve dangers and risks of injury including, but not limited to, broken bones, cuts, scrapes, bruises, paralysis, and death. These specific risks, as well as general risks involved with the Live Performances, are specifically acknowledged and contemplated by the parties to this Release.
3. The above-named individual acknowledges that he or she is responsible for abiding by any rules provided for the Live Performances whether in written form or by oral description, and further agrees to abide by such rules.
4. In the event the above-named individual is a minor, the parent/guardian of such minor child hereby acknowledges, consents to, and agrees to the terms of this Release, and specifically consents to the minor child's participation in Live Performances occurring on the premises of SKYZONE.
5. The undersigned release SKYZONE, its owners, employees, and related entities from any and all liability resulting from injuries of any nature sustained by the above-named individual, by, through, or related to the participation in any Live Performances as described above in Section 1 and occurring on the premises of SKYZONE, provided such injuries are not caused by any acts of SKYZONE, its employees or owners, that are willfully and intentionally directed at causing injuries to the above-named individual. Acts by SKYZONE and its employees and owners that are agreed not to give rise to liability include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - (i) Negligence, including carelessness or failure to exercise ordinary care;
 - (ii) Failure to take reasonable precautions;
 - (iii) Any actions taken by a live performer whether or not on stage;
 - (iv) Recklessness;
 - (v) Gross negligence, or
 - (vi) Strict liability.
